To Whom It May Concern:


The QuikClot products for which you have requested an SDS (formerly known as Material Safety Data Sheet – MSDS) are manufactured or distributed by Z-Medica, LLC and meet the requirements of an Article as defined in the OSHA Hazard Communication Regulation (29 CFR 1910.1200). Products classified as Articles are considered exempt from the OSHA Hazard Communication Regulations. The exemption and definition of an Article is set forth in Section 6 of 29 CFR 1910.1200.

Section 6 (c) Definitions

Article means a manufactured item other than a fluid or particle: (i) which is formed to a specific shape or design during manufacture; (ii) which has end use function(s) dependent in whole or in part upon its shape or design during end use; and which under normal conditions of use does not release more than very small quantities, e.g., minute or trace amounts of a hazardous chemical (as determined under paragraph (d) of this section, and does not pose a physical hazard or health risk to employees.

QuikClot products in their marketed packaging are generally not considered hazardous under normal conditions of use when used in accordance with labeling instructions.
